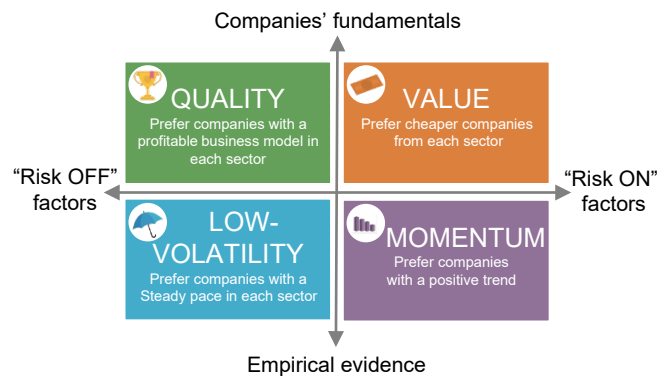

OBJECTIVE

- The THEAM Quant - Equity World DEFI Fund aims to increase the value of its assets over the medium term by being exposed to a dynamic basket of equities listed on global markets, the components of which are chosen using a systematic selection method based on fundamental and technical analysis of the companies' shares.

KEY POINTS

- The THEAM Quant - Equity World DEFI Fund is exposed to the global equity markets
- DEFI Strategy combines equity factors for a pre-defined tracking error positioning
- It attempts to generate excess return over traditional market cap weighted indices
- The strategy is based on a systematic investment process that selects equities through a combination of four investment style factors: Quality, Value, Low-Vol and Momentum
- An allocation mechanism which aims at controlling the relative risk between this factor allocation and the benchmark index is implemented



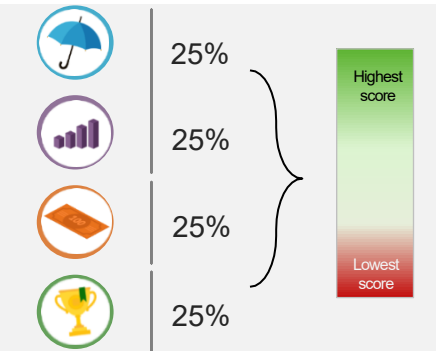
STRATEGY

1. Calculation of the factors



- For each factor, all the stocks from the universe are scored
- The scoring calculation includes a methodology aiming to neutralize biases (sector, region, size)

2. Risk budgeting



- Factor scores (or alpha) are combined to create a global score
- Risk budgets are allocated to each factor (25% each)

3. Portfolio construction

- Long-only
- Beta: 1 (use of futures)
- Weights ranging from 0.2% to 2%
- Ex-ante tracking error: 3.5% (with regards to the MSCI World Net Return USD Index)
- Turnover control
- Between 75 and 100 stocks

- The final portfolio aims to replicate at best the global score while taking into account investment constraints

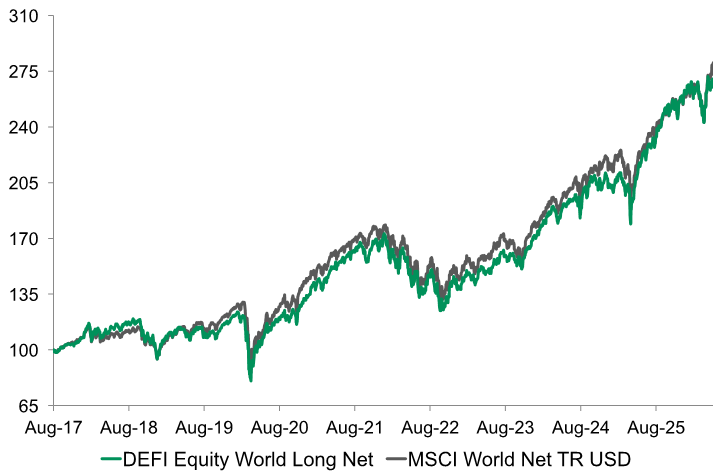

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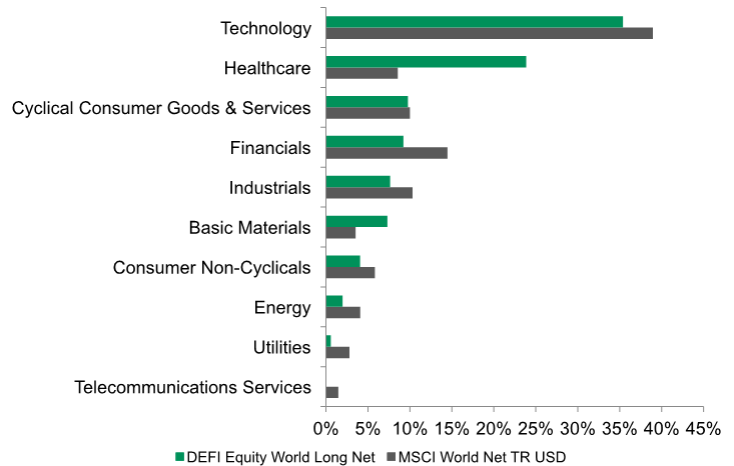

Funds' main common risks

Economic conditions

The funds will possess inherent risks

Currency exchange risk

Credit risk

Risk linked to equity markets

Counterparty risk
