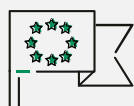

Scoring

Stocks are rated according to four low correlated metrics that best represent the Growth factor:

- 5Y Capex Growth
- Internal Growth Rate
- 5Y Number of employees evolution
- 1Y Sales Forward Growth



ESG integration

Exclusion: Critical controversies check and ESG screenings (i.e. *energy transition score below 30%*).

Integration: ESG score of each company impacts its expected return & allocation.

Guarantee: ESG characteristics to be better than investment universe.



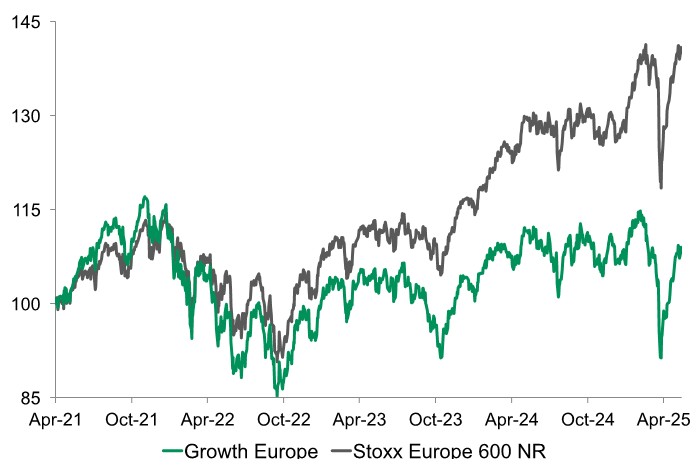
Optimization process

Implemented at the end to maximize the exposure to the Growth Factor under constraints such as the **maximum volatility of alpha below 4%**.

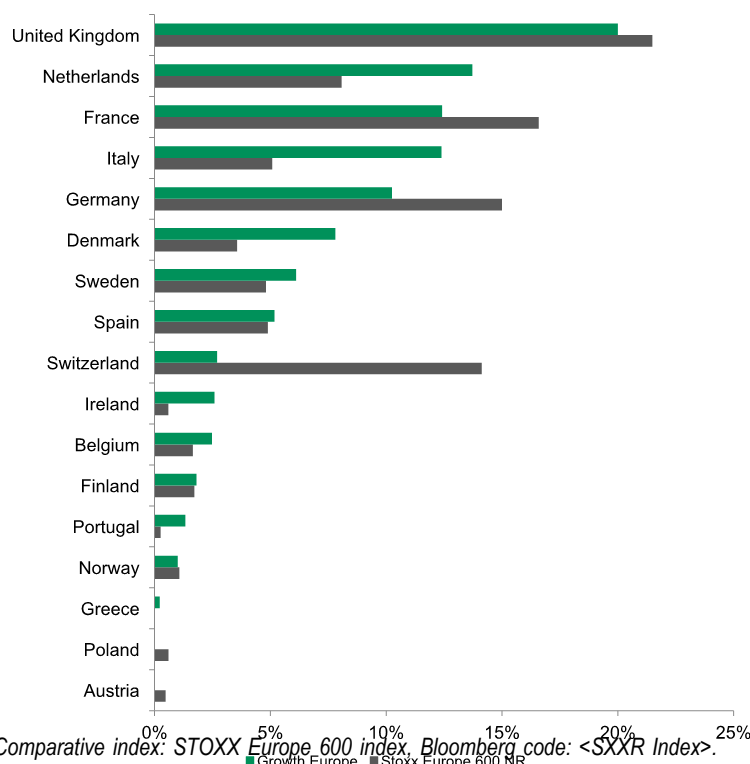
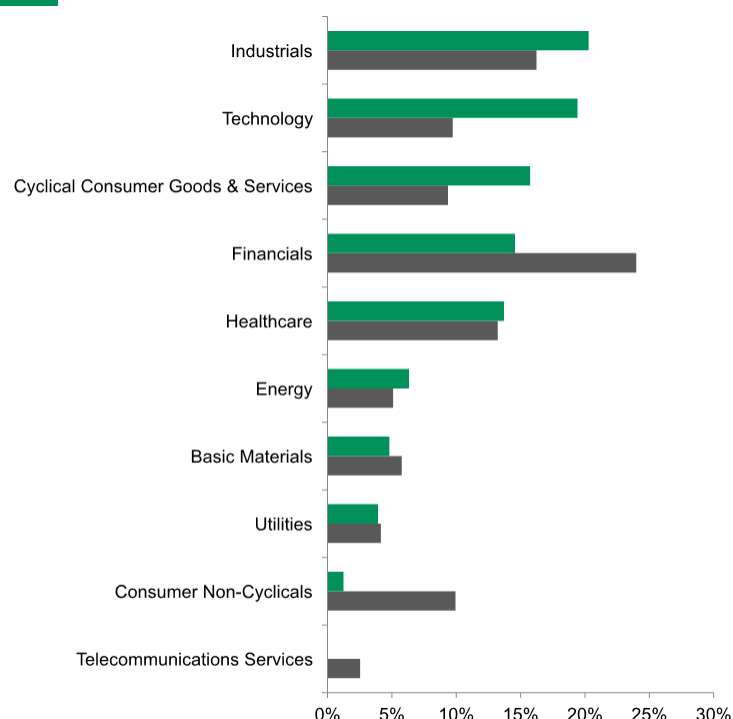

INVESTMENT GUIDELINES

1. Investment Objective

- Replicate the performance of the **BNP Paribas Growth Europe ESG Index** (Bloomberg: *BNPIFEGE Index*), including fluctuations, and to maintain the Tracking Error between the sub-fund and the index below 1%.

2. Benchmark

- The benchmark is the **BNP Paribas Growth Europe ESG Index**, published in EUR. The composition of the index is reviewed on a monthly basis. The index is valued daily. **BNP Paribas Growth Europe ESG Index** measures the performance of European companies whose growth rate is above the average of the industry and the market.

3. Investment Guidelines¹

- Long-only equity fund
- The strategy is implemented through a synthetic replication of the index. Exposure to the index is achieved by entering into a swap that enables the sub-fund to convert the exposure of its 'substitute basket' to the exposure to the index
- The sub-fund will not invest more than 10% of its net assets in shares or units issued by UCITS or other UCIs

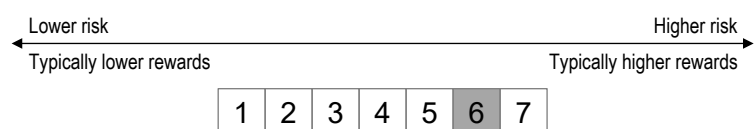
