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INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

- companies' financial robustness

In a world where the necessity to tackle environmental and social challenges keeps strengthening, the investment landscape has been rewritten with all players in the investment value chain shifting their focus towards long-term sustainable solutions.

The Equity World Global Goals strategy offers investors more opportunities to take part in this transformation.

The strategy targets a diversified selection of developed world companies that display high Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) standards and a positive financial outlook, while contributing to the achievement of the United Nations' 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

MONTHLY COMMENTARY

MACRO BACKGROUND

In April, our fund performed negatively: -3.89%, yet underperforming the MSCI World Net Total Return USD Index by -0.20% over the duration of this month.

PERFORMANCE BREAKDOWN

The performance of THEAM Quant - Equity World Global Goals was mainly due to the following:

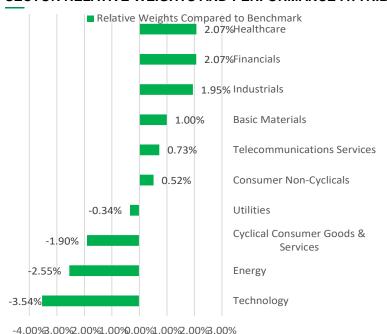
- Our selections within the Financials and Basic Materials sectors underperformed those of the benchmark (resp. -0.8 % and -1.5 %), a loss amplified by our strong relative over allocation (resp. +5.5 % and +1.5 %).
- Within the Industrials sector, stock picking underperformed that of the MSCI World Net Total Return USD Index (-4.3 % versus -2.6 %) on the back of, for example, the poor performance of UNITED RENTALS (-7.4 %, weighted at 1.0 %).
- Conversely, despite our selection within the United States underperformed by -0.9 %, our stronger relative under weighting (-20 %) in this sector generated a gain.
- Lastly, within the Consumer Non-Cyclicals and the Cyclical Consumer Goods & Services sectors, our equity selection outperformed by resp. 3.5 % and 1.1 %.
- A sector analysis shows a rise of 0.6 % and 0.2 % for the Consumer Non-Cyclicals and the Utilities sectors (weighted at 9.4 % and 3.4 % respectively).
 On the contrary, Technology and Industrials fell by 0.9 % and 0.1 % (weighted at 20.0 % and 13.0 % respectively).

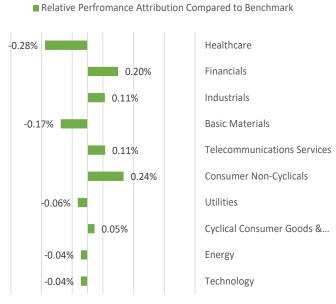

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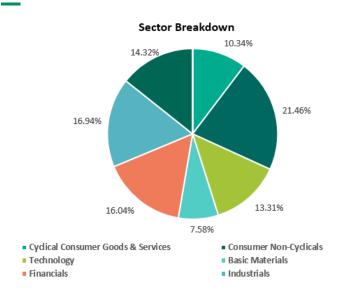

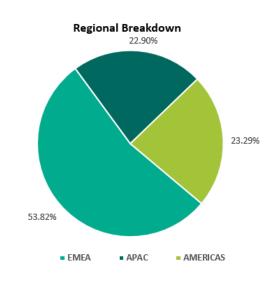

WHAT ARE THE RISKS?
