- An ESG Filtering Criteria is applied to the Initial Investment Portfolio, selecting only the most complying companies.

INVESTMENT PROCESS



With an average daily trading volume above 10 Mio EUR.



Stocks are rated according to the two metrics that best represent Low Vol factor:

- 3-Year Historical Volatility
- Earnings Per Share Dispersion



Exclusion: Critical controversies check and ESG screenings (i.e. energy transition score below 30%)

Integration: ESG score of each company impacts its expected return & allocation.

Guarantee: ESG characteristics to be better than investment universe.



Optimization process

Implemented at the end to maximize the exposure to the Low Vol Factor under constraints such as the maximum volatility of alpha below 4%



INVESTMENT GUIDELINES

1. Investment Objective

• Replicate the performance of the BNP Paribas Low Vol Europe ESG Index (Bloomberg: BNPIFELE Index), including fluctuations, and to maintain the Tracking Error between the sub-fund and the index below 1%.

2. Benchmark

- The benchmark is the BNP Paribas Low Vol Europe ESG Index, published in EUR. The composition of the index is reviewed on a monthly basis.
 The index is valued daily. BNP Paribas Low Vol Europe ESG Index measures the performance of European companies whose historical volatility is low.

3. Investment Guidelines¹

- · Long-only equity fund
- The strategy is implemented through a synthetic replication of the index. Exposure to the index is achieved by entering into a swap that enables the sub-fund to convert the exposure of its 'substitute basket' to the exposure to the index
- The sub-fund will not invest more than 10% of its net assets in shares or units issued by UCITS or other UCIs

ETF CHARACTERISTICS

The BNP PARIBAS EASY ESG LOW VOL EUROPE UCITS ETF is a Sub-fund of BNP Paribas Easy, a UCITS compliant SICAV registered under Luxembourg law.
