This Fund is managed by BNP PARIBAS ASSET MANAGEMENT Luxembourg, part of the BNP Paribas Group.

Objectives and investment policy

The Fund belongs to the category of fund of funds. It seeks to increase the value of its assets over the medium to long term by mainly investing in UCITS and/or UCI providing exposure to different asset classes (e.g. shares, bonds, real estate investments, alternative investments, and money market instruments). The remaining portion of assets may be invested directly in equities, debt securities, money market instruments and/or ancillary cash. The Fund is actively managed without reference to an index.

The asset class mix will change based on the Investment Manager's short and medium market views of the investment team.

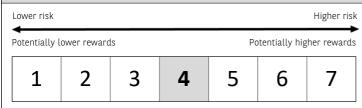
The allowable bandwidths across the different asset classes are: Equities: 0-80%, Bonds: 0-100%, Money Market: 0-45%, Real Estate Investments(1): 0-25%, Alternative Investments(2) (Real Estate Investment excluded): 0-30%.

(1) The sub-fund does not hold real estate directly. Real Estate Investments made under the Real Estate Securities asset class will be composed of Close-ended REITS only.

(2) Alternative investments will mainly focus on Absolute Return Funds while not being limited solely to this type of Funds. Incomes are systematically reinvested.

Investors are able to redeem on a daily basis (on Luxembourg bank business days) as described in the prospectus.

Risk and reward profile

- <u>Credit</u> <u>Risk</u>: This risk relates to the ability of an issuer to honour its commitments: downgrades of an issue or issuer rating may lead to a drop in the value of associated bonds.
- <u>Operational and Custody Risk</u>: Some markets are less regulated than most of the international markets; hence, the services related to custody and liquidation for the subfund on such markets could be more risky.
