# DAILY REPORT

## INDONESIA MARKET WRAP

---

### EQUITY MARKET

#### Rebound

JCI advanced and closed at 8,407 (+45 points or +0.53%) today. Shares across regional markets were mixed. Meanwhile, foreign investors recorded net inflow of IDR 1.7Tn today and rupiah slightly strengthened to IDR 16,703/USD.

Banking stocks were mixed as BBCA (+0.89%), BMRI (+1.25%), and BBRI (+0.76%) rose, while BBTN (-0.83%) and BNL1 (-1.47%) closed lower. Consumer names were mostly positive as KLBF (+4.24%), UNVR (+2.79%), ICBP (+0.9%), and INDF (+0.36%) all rose, except MYOR (-0.94%). Telco stocks were positive as TLKM (+0.83%), ISAT (+3.41%), and EXCL (+1.48%) all inched higher. Material names were negative as BRPT (-2.23%) and TPIA (-4%) all corrected. Other movers were SGRO (+19.92%), MPRO (+7.41%), SHIP (-5.38%), and BKSL (-5.15%).

Gaikindo stated that national CBU car exports reached 427,000 units in 10M25, up +9.1% year-on-year. Gaikindo is optimistic that national car exports will reach around 500,000 units by the end of the year (+6% year-on-year).

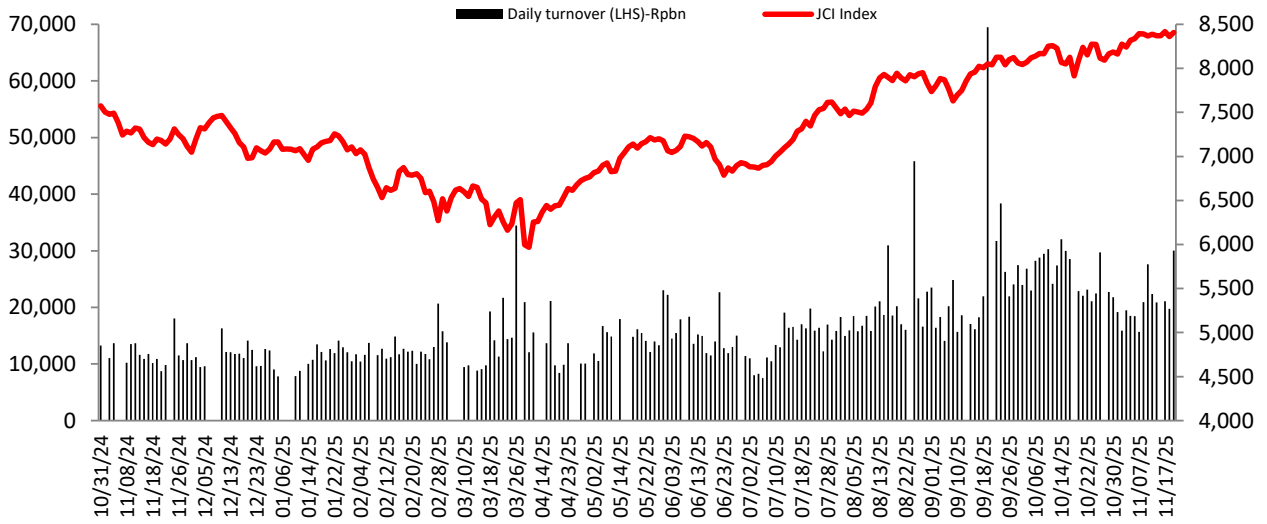
### BOND MARKET

#### BI KEPT BENCHMARK RATE AT 4.75%

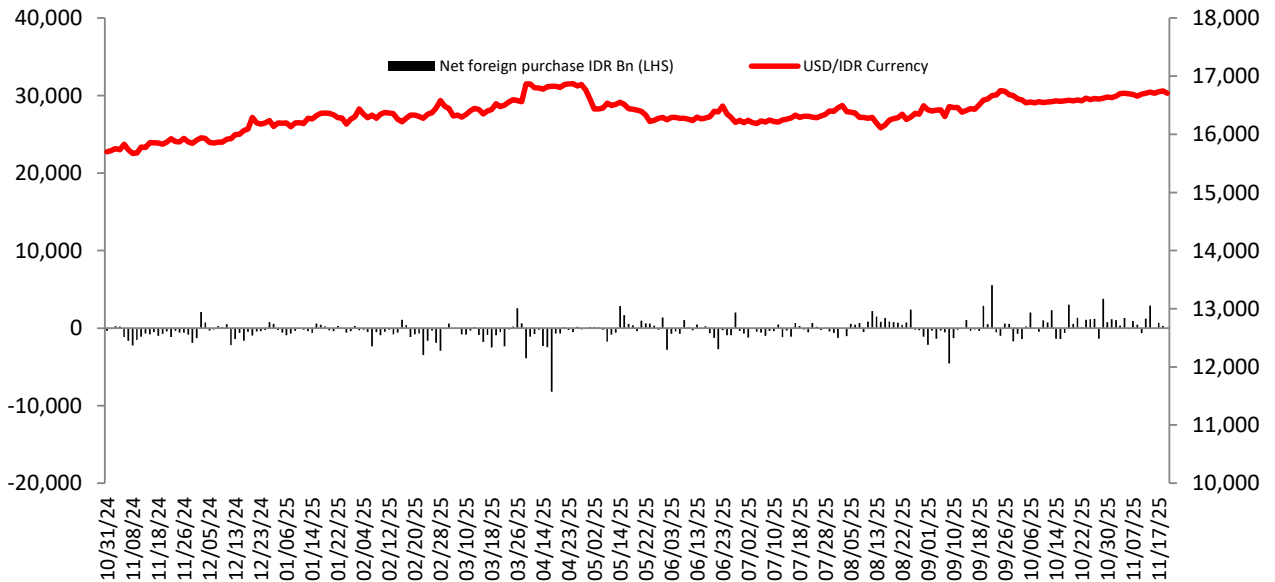
Indonesia bond market opened on light flow ahead of BI meeting this afternoon. Morning session saw buying interest in short tenor below 4Y with yields lower by 3-5bps. On afternoon session, BI announced that they kept the benchmark rate unchanged this month, in line with market expectations. Hence, there were little to no reaction towards the news. BI focus remained on Rupiah stability and they reiterated the need to see transmission of recent rate cuts to materialize. Overall, the yield curve showed bull steepened movement, with 5/10/15/20Y benchmark series closed the day at mid yield 5.41%/6.12%/6.37%/6.51%.
