INDONESIA MARKET WRAP

EQUITY MARKET

LOWER

JCI weakened and closed at 6,117 (-60 points or -0.98%) today. Shares across regional markets were mixed. Meanwhile, foreign investors recorded net outflow of IDR - 1.1Tn today and rupiah slightly weakened to IDR 17,832/USD.

Banking stocks were negative as MEGA (-2.37%), BBNI (-4.9%), BMRI (-2.09%), BBKA (-1.19%), and BBRI (-2.05%) all corrected. Consumer names were mixed as GGRM (+2.86%) and HMSP (+2.33%) rose, while ICBP (-1.87%), KLBF (-2.86%), and MYOR (-7.04%) retreated. Material stocks were negative as TPIA (-6.31%) and BRPT (-6.47%) all weakened. Poultry names were negative as MAIN (-2.13%), JPFA (-1.3%), and CPIN (-4.52%) all weakened. Other movers were BYAN (+20%), ADES (+17.14%), SRAJ (-7.5%), and IMPC (-5.03%).

Director General of Taxes of the Ministry of Finance (Kemenkeu) stated that tax revenue as of 16 June 2026 reached Rp940/3tn, +23.4% YoY or 40% of 2026 target

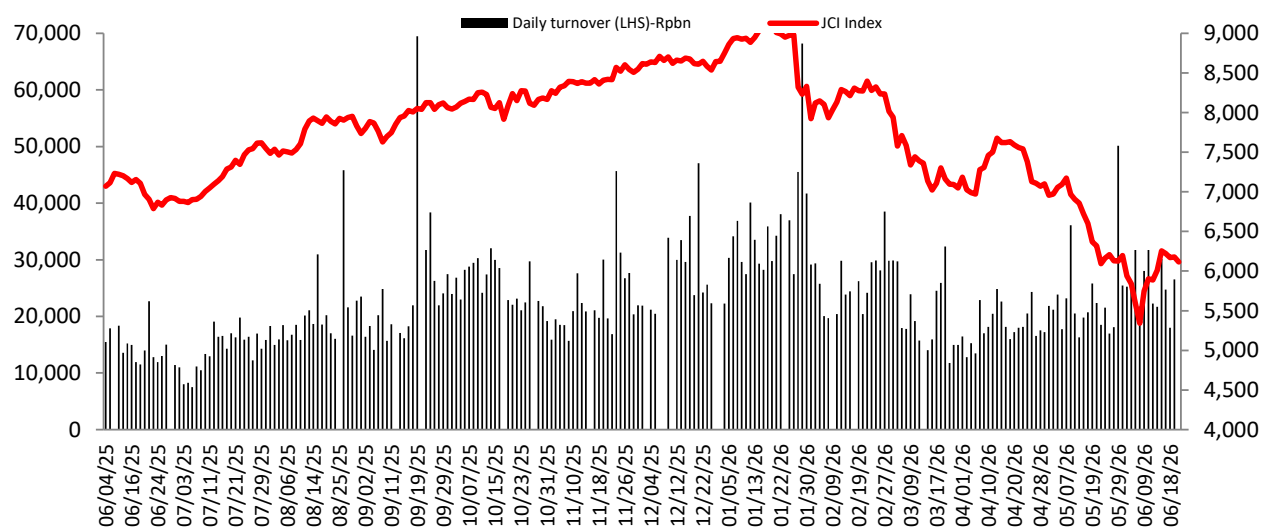
BOND MARKET

LITTLE CHANGE

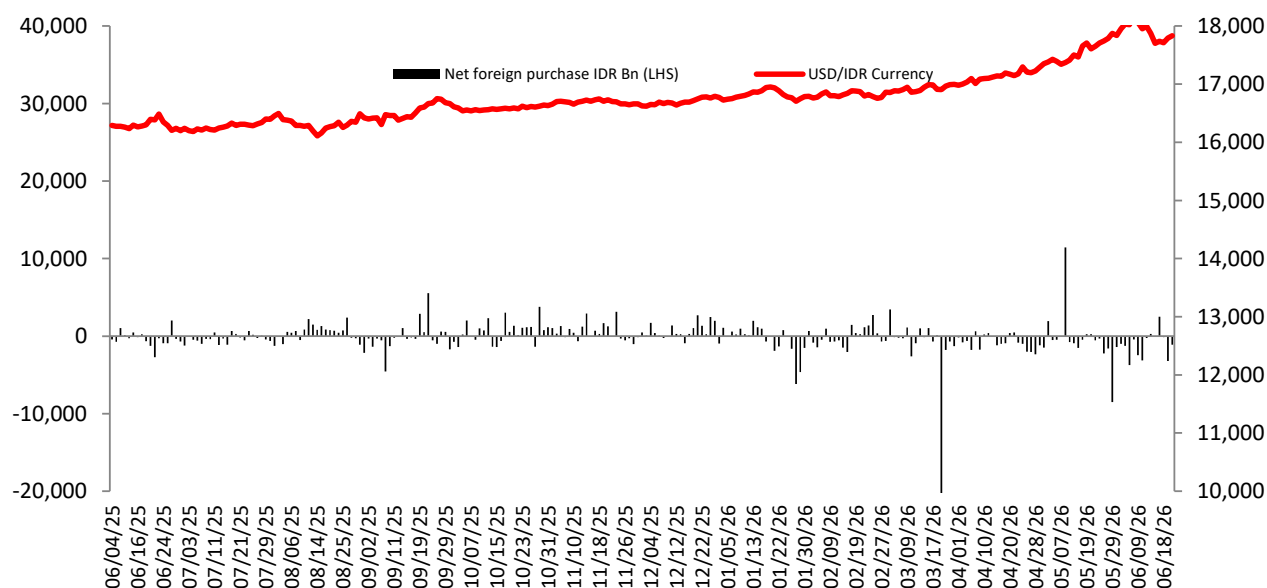
Indonesia bond market start the week with wide spread and softer tone. Limited activities remained focus on 5Y and 10Y area while the other part of the yield curve was quoted within range throughout the day. There is not much activity both from local and foreign as most players prepared for tomorrow auction. By the end of day yield curve closed slightly higher by 2 – 5bps. There will be fresh supply tomorrow as Indonesia Debt Management Office (“DMO”) will hold conventional bond auction with IDR 36Tn issuance target. The series that will be issued are 1M SPN, 3M SPN, 1Y SPN, 5Y FR109, 10Y FR108, 15Y FR106, 20Y FR107, 30Y FR102 and 40Y FR105. In the previous conventional auction, incoming bids reached IDR 46.69Tn and DMO issued IDR 26.35Tn.
