

INDEX DESCRIPTION:

The Index is composed of companies selected on the basis of a minimum Environmental, Social and Corporate Governance (ESG) criteria (environmental opportunity, pollution and waste, human capital, corporate governance, etc.) and based on their efforts to reduce their exposure to coal and unconventional fossil fuels. It implements a cap that limits a company's maximum weight within the Index to 5% on each rebalancing date. In addition, the index aims to comply with the Paris Aligned Benchmark (PAB) targets of reducing carbon intensity by at least 50% relative to the initial investment universe and achieving an additional decarbonisation target of 7% each year. As a result, companies involved in sectors with a potentially high negative ESG impact, those subject to significant violations of the UN Global Compact principles and those involved in severe ESG-related controversies are excluded from the Index. The type of approach used here is Best-in-class (Best-inclass approach identifies leaders in each sector based on the best ESG practices, while avoiding those that present high levels of risk and do not comply with minimum ESG standards according to the Index administrator and its specialised partners). The extra-financial strategy of the Index, carried out at each step of the investment process, may comprise methodological limitations such as the risk related to ESG investment or the Index rebalancing. BNPP AM's internal ESG scoring methodology determines an issuer's ESG score by evaluating performance vs. scoring peers on a narrow set of key ESG issues related to the environment (e.g. climate change), social issues (e.g. human resources management) and governance (e.g. independence and competence of directors). BNPP AM uses numerous research inputs and data sources (e.g. Sustainalytic, ISS & Trucost) to determine issuers' ESG scores. If the issuer's commitments and practices on a pillar of assessment (E,S or G) is better than scoring peers, it will receive a positive 'contribution'for this pillar. Each issuer is assigned a final score from 1 to 99 which is the result of 50 as a reference plus the sum of the contributions from each of the three pillars.

ESG Contribution

The ESG contributions are determined by BNP Paribas Asset Management's ESG analysts on the basis of detailed criteria to systematically evaluate companies' commitments and practices in the areas of environmental, social and governance. Each of the above contributions at the portfolio level, is the weighted average of the contributions of the individual portfolio holdings.Environmental Contribution (E) takes into account, among other things, climate change, environmental risk management, and the use of natural resources. Social Contribution (S) takes into account, among other things, human capital management, the quality of social dialogue, and the respect of diversity. Governance Contribution (G) takes into account, among other things, on executive compensation, the fight against corruption, and gender equality.

Portfolio Coverage

The coverage represents, within an Index replicated by the fund, the percentage of securities that have an ESG score or carbon footprint using BNPP AM's internalmethodology which can be lower than the full coverage offered per the index provider

MSCI ESG Fund Rating

The MSCI ESG rating is calculated as a direct mapping of ESG Quality Scores to letter rating categories (e.g. AAA = 8.6-10). The ESG Ratings range from leader (AAA:AA), average (A, BBB, BB) to laggard (B, CCC).

MSCI Weighted Average Carbon Intensity

It measures a funds's exposure to carbon intensive companies. This figure represents the estimated greenhouse gas emissions per \$1 million in sales across the fund's holdings. This allows for comparisons between funds of different sizes.

MSCI Weighted Average Carbon Intensity Coverage.

It is the percentage of the fund's holdings for which MSCI Carbon Intensity data is available. The MSCI Weighted Average Carbon Intensity metric is displayed for funds with any coverage. Funds with low coverage may not fully represent the fund's carbon characteristics given the lack of coverage.

MSCI ESG Quality Score (0-10)

The MSCI ESG Quality Score (0-10) for funds is calculated using the weighted average of the ESG scores of fund holdings. The Score also considers ESG rating trend of holdings and the fund exposure to holdings in the laggard category. MSCI rates underlying holdings according to their exposure to industry specific ESG risks and their ability to manage those risks relative to peers.

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GLOSSARY

Tracking Error

The tracking error measures the volatility of a portfolio's relative return in relation to its benchmark index.

Volatility

An asset's volatility is the standard deviation of its return. As a measure of dispersion, it evaluates the uncertainty of asset prices, which is often equated to their risk. Volatility can be calculated ex post (retrospectively) or estimated ex ante (anticipatively).
